FAQs

1) What are the available B.Tech. streams and their respective intake capacities for SIT First Year Engineering admissions?

The available B.Tech. streams and their respective intake capacities for SIT First Year Engineering admissions are as follows:

- B.Tech. Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning: 30 seats
- **B.Tech. Computer Engineering:** 30 seats
- B.Tech. Computer Science and Engineering: 120 seats
- B.Tech. Computer Science and Technology: 30 seats
- B.Tech. Computer Science and Engineering(Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning): 60 seats

Candidates can choose their preferred stream based on their choice.

2) What are the important dates for the admission process, including registration, test dates, and the start of the B.Tech program at Symbiosis Institute of Technology?

The important dates for the SIT Hyderabad 2025 admission process are as follows:

- SITEEE Registration and Payment Closes on: April 12, 2025 (Saturday)
- SITEEE Admit Card Live: April 25, 2025 (Friday) for SITEEE Test 01 & April 30, 2025 (Wednesday) for SITEEE Test 02
- Test 01: May 5, 2025 (Monday), 11:30 am to 12:30 pm
- Test 02: May 11, 2025 (Sunday), 11:30 am to 12:30 pm
- Announcement of SITEEE Result: May 22, 2025 (Thursday)

Note: All these dates are subject to the respective entrance exam results declaration. Candidates should regularly check the official website for updates.

3) How can candidates apply for SIT First Year Engineering admissions through different entrance exams?

Candidates can apply for SIT First Year Engineering admissions through the following methods:

- SITEEE:
 - o Candidates need to register on the provided link https://set2025.ishinfosys.com/SET20Y25/Register/Index.aspx.
 - o Appear for the SIT Engineering Entrance Exam (SITEEE).
- JEE (Main):
 - o Candidates can register using the link: https://ezapp.ishinfo.com/SITHYD25/Register/Index.aspx
 - o Admissions will be based on their 2025 JEE (Main) scores.
- Any State Government Exam:
 - o Register through the link: https://ezapp.ishinfo.com/SITHYD25/Register/Index.aspx.

o Admissions will be considered based on their 2025 score in any State Government Engineering Entrance Examination.

For updates on registration links, candidates are advised to check the official SIT website regularly.

4) What is the syllabus for the Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) for Engineering programs?

The syllabus for the Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) for Engineering programs is based on the CBSE Class 11 and Class 12 curriculum for Physics, Mathematics, and Chemistry.

For detailed topics, a link to the syllabus will be provided on the official website soon. Candidates are advised to refer to the CBSE curriculum for preparation in the meantime.

5) Will the admission rounds be conducted online?

Yes, the admission rounds will be conducted online. Candidates will receive an offered branch letter via email after the merit is generated.

6) What are the registration instructions and fee details for SITEEE candidates applying to Symbiosis Institute of Technology?

The registration process and fee details for SITEEE candidates are as follows:

 - o SITEEE Entrance Test Registration Fee: INR 2250/- per test (Non-refundable and non-transferable).

- Important Note:
 - Both SITEEE test registration and SIT Hyderabad institute registration are mandatory for admission to first-year B.Tech programs at SIT Hyderabad.
 - o Ensure both registrations are completed to secure eligibility for the admission process.

7) What are the registration instructions and fee details for JEE (Main)/Any State Government Engineering Entrance Exam candidates applying to Symbiosis Institute of Technology?

The registration process and fee details are as follows:

 - o The registration fee is INR 1500/-.
 - o The fee is waived for candidates who have already paid the SITEEE and SIT Hyderabad registration fees (INR 2250 + INR 1000).

Ensure you complete the registration process on time to be considered for admission through JEE (Main) or Any State Government Engineering Entrance Exam scores.

8) Do candidates need to register separately for SITEEE and JEE (Main) / State Government Entrance Examination-based admissions, and is there an additional registration fee required?

Yes, candidates are required to register separately for both SITEEE and JEE (Main) / Any State Government Engineering Entrance Examination based admissions. However, there is no additional registration fee for JEE (Main) or Any State Government Engineering Entrance Examination if the candidate has already paid the registration fee for SITEEE.

9) Is registration mandatory for the 2025 SIT admissions, and what happens if a candidate does not complete it?

Yes, registration is mandatory for the 2025 SIT admissions. Candidates who do not complete the registration process will not be considered for the admission process and will be ineligible for counselling or seat allotment.

It is essential to complete the registration to participate in the admission procedure.

10) Can a candidate with a PCM aggregate below 45% (General category) or 40% (Reserved category) in the 12th standard secure admission at SIT if they have a good competitive exam score?

No, candidates must meet the minimum PCM aggregate requirement of 45% for the General category and 40% for the Reserved category in the 12th standard. Admission is not possible at SIT if the aggregate percentage in the defined subjects falls below these thresholds, regardless of their competitive exam score. 11) What are the specific documents required to be uploaded for the Symbiosis Institute of Technology B.Tech, SIT Hyderabad admissions, and where should candidates submit them?

The following documents are required for B.Tech, SIT Hyderabad admissions:

- Entrance Examination Score Card:
 - o SITEEE / JEE (Main) / Any State Government Engineering Entrance Examination (Compulsory)
- 12th Mark List:
 - o Not compulsory for admission rounds due to delayed board results.
 - o E-mark sheets may be uploaded when available on the examination board's website.
 - o Minimum PCM % (45% for General, 40% for Reserved category) is a mandatory eligibility requirement.
- Address Proof (Compulsory)
- Caste Certificate (Compulsory if applicable)
- Gap Certificate (Compulsory if applicable)

- Change of Name Certificate (if applicable)
- Differently-Abled Certificate:
 - o Issued by the Symbiosis Centre for Health Care (Compulsory if applicable)
- Soft Copy of Candidate Photograph (Compulsory)

Submission Process:

12) Which web browsers are compatible for registering on the SIT Hyderabad 2025 application portal?

The SIT Hyderabad 2025 application portal is compatible with the following web browsers:

- Internet Explorer: Version 6.0 or above.
- **Other Browsers:** Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, and similar browsers also support the application portal.

Candidates are advised to use updated versions of their preferred browsers for a smooth registration process.

13) How can I enable JavaScript in my browser to complete the registration for SIT Hyderabad?

16) Is it mandatory to complete both Part-1 and Part-2 of the registration form for JEE(Main)/ASGEEE to participate in the admission process for SIT Hyderabad?

Yes, it is mandatory to complete and submit both Part-1 and Part-2 of the registration form to participate in the SIT Hyderabad admission process. Candidates who fail to submit both parts of the registration form will not be eligible to participate in the admission counselling rounds.

Ensure that both sections are completed before the deadline to avoid disqualification.

No, there is no specific cut-off for the SITEEE/JEE/ASGEEE entrance exam. Candidates are evaluated based on their performance, and the selection is done according to the overall merit and seat availability.
